GA Air Quality Rules require that operators in the 13 county Metropolitan Atlanta area shall ensure that at least one facility representative receives training and instruction in the operation and maintenance of the specific Stage II vapor recovery system in use at the facility. EPD Inspectors will be checking for this Training Certificate.
