

Are you ready for the new Hours of Service?

FMCSA just released the long-awaited changes to Part 395...the new hours of service requirements for the trucking industry. It's not a lot of language (just 12 pages) but it includes provisions that start this year and some that don't take effect until 2013. There is a mandatory 30 minute 'break' for all drivers within the first 8 hours on-duty, new limitations on the 34 hour restart rule and new penalties for "egregious" violations.
