**Safety Council Dinner Meeting & Reasonable Suspicion Training for Supervisors**

Please join us on July 30 at the Green Manor in Union City for a special training seminar for you and your driver supervisors. This training session is being conducted by Safety First, a division of Behavioral Health Systems, and it combines two exceptional programs into one. Attendees will be compliant with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations requiring all supervisors to be trained for one hour on the signs and symptoms of controlled substances and one hour on the signs and symptoms of alcohol abuse. Additionally, attendees will receive certification as a Designated Employer Representative using curriculum developed by the Drug and Alcohol Testing Industry Association (DATIA). It provides a comprehensive overview of the entire drug and alcohol testing process. Certifications for each component of the program will be provided.

**LEARNING OBJECTIVES FOR ATTENDEES INCLUDE:**

- \* Identification of substance abusers in the workplace
- \* Proper methods to conduct a reasonable suspicion test
- \* Determine who is covered by the regulations
- \* 100% percent compliance with drug and alcohol testing regulations
- \* Define the role of the DER in the testing process and with various service agents (BATs, TPAs, MROs, collectors, SAPs, etc.)
- \* Problem drug tests
- \* Action to take after receiving a positive drug or alcohol test result
- \* Record keeping

Mr. Erle Moring, Vice President of Safety First, will be bringing us up to date on the latest FMCSA medical regulations, recent trends in drug use and proper methods of creating awareness and education among your employees.
